SWISS SCHOOL FLEA MARKET HOUSE RULES

- The Flea Market takes place in the Multi Purpose Hall (MPH) of the Swiss School Singapore.
- The Flea Market is organized by the SSiS Parentsforum and the Swiss School.
- The Flea Market is a second-hand market from children, for children. You can sell anything you want (toys, books, clothes, etc.) if not broken or damaged. No professional sale is allowed.
- The sale is free and open to the children of the Swiss School in Singapore and their parents. External sellers please contact organizers upon arrival and pay a contribution of 20 SGD which will be donated to the charities that the School supports.
- Sellers can set prices for their goods and can keep their earnings.
- Each seller must bring a blanket or mat and is only allowed to display the goods for sale on the blanket or mat, and not on the floor; the blanket or mat is mandatory and organisers reserve the right to stop a seller from participating where there is no blanket or mat.
- There is no registration and no reservation of spaces.
- The doors of the MPH open at 9am sharp; vendors can set up their goods on a first come first serve basis after 9am.
- Sale is from 10am to 1pm.
- The Swiss Club Car Park is open only for Swiss Club Members. Non-Swiss Club Members are required to use the Visitors' Car Park.
- Vendors are allowed to use the Bus Bay Area to unload their goods, but cars have to exit immediately after unloading as the space is needed for the Charity Car Wash.
- Vendors have to clean up and take their unsold goods back home at the end of the event.
